★ Whispering Hills Recycling & Trash Disposal ★

Whispering Hills Recycling Dumpsters Are Adjacent To The Tennis Courts

Container #1: Aluminum Foil, Aluminum Pie Plates, Foil Pans, Aluminum/Tin Cans, Aerosol Cans, Milk Cartons, Juice Boxes, White Frozen Food Containers, Plastic Containers (#1 to #7 in a triangle) and Clear, Green and Brown Glass Bottles and Jars (caps and labels off). All items must be rinsed prior to discarding and should not be in plastic bags!

Container #2: Flattened Cardboard Boxes, Flattened Corrugated Cardboard, Chipboard Egg Cartons (excluding Styrofoam Egg Containers). Styrofoam and other packing materials should be disposed of as regular garbage or brought to a Recycling Center.

Container #3: Newspapers, Junk Mail/Magazines, Soft Covered Books, Telephone Books, Kraft Paper (i.e. brown bags), Shredded Paper, Computer Paper and Office Paper. Please do not dispose of items in plastic bags, as the hauling company will not take them!

Regular Household Trash Disposal:

Regular household trash must be in sealed plastic bags. Please <u>do not</u> empty trashcans or wastebaskets directly into a dumpster. When the dumpster is emptied, the loose items will be blown around the community as litter. If a dumpster is full, trash should be deposited in another dumpster. Recyclables should be put in a recyclable container as outlined above. Please notify the HOA office at 845-469-4018 if a dumpster is damaged or overfull.

Examples of Acceptable Trash Items:

Paper:

- Paper soiled with grease, food, paint, etc. Wax-coated paper Paper plates and cups
- Tissues, toilet paper, paper towels and napkins Paper items with layers of plastic/foil
- Hard covered books (or remove the covers and/or metal spiral and recycle)
- Paper used for animal training or bedding (or kitty litter)
- Diapers/pull-ups

Other Items:

- Pots, pans, bowls, utensils and other cookware Plastic/ceramic/china dinnerware/
- Plastic buckers, planters, baskets or bins
- Plastic bags (or they can be recycled at the Orange County Transfer Station)
- Styrofoam cups, plates, bowls (Styrofoam peanuts can be recycled at the Orange County Transfer Station in Goshen)
- Light bulbs (except fluorescent, which should be brought to the Orange County Transfer station)
- Metal/Plastic clothing hangers

Bulk Item Disposal:

Disposal of large items such as furniture, appliances, etc. is the responsibility of each resident/homeowner. They are not to be left at the regular trash dumpsters, at the recycling areas or along any roadway. A large roll-off dumpster is located beyond a locked gate on the hill above Clubhouse II. Bulk items can be taken there during normal office hours (8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday to Friday). Persons requesting to use this area must first sign in at the HOA office in Clubhouse II. *Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers or any appliances containing Freon cannot be put in the Whispering Hills roll off dumpster! *

Appliances Containing Freon: should be removed by the company delivering the new appliances, or you may take them to the Orange County Transfer Station located on Route 17M in Goshen, NY. The Orange County Transfer Station hours are Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm and Saturday from 8:00 am to noon. *There is a fee and they only take cash or a credit card.* Please contact the Orange County Transfer Station directly at (845) 374-1925 with any questions.

Carpeting & Mattresses: should be removed by the company delivering the new carpeting/mattress, the HOA <u>cannot</u> accept them in the roll-off dumpster.

WARNING: Violators of any trash disposal/recycling regulation will be subject to fines without further warning!
