OUTSIDE WATER FAUCET TURNOFF PROCEDURE

All Outside Faucets Are To Be Turned Off And Drained
By **November 1, 2007**

Failure to turn off and properly drain the outside faucet has resulted in <u>freezing and bursting of pipes</u>, which may cause flooding of your unit. Any resulting damages would be a Homeowner responsibility.

Procedure to Turn Off Outside Faucets

Turn off inside shutoff valve. These are located as follows:

| Type of Unit | Location of Inside Shutoff Valve |
|---|---|
| Aspen (2 bedrooms; 1 bath | Alcove in Garage |
| Butternut (3 bedrooms; 2 baths) | Alcove in Garage |
| Dogwood (3 Bedrooms; 2.5 baths) heater | Underneath kitchen Cabinets (by sink) or near hot water |
| Cedar (2 bedrooms; 1.5 baths) | Closet (by Hot Water Heater) |

- 2. Go outside and open outside faucet on the building Outside faucet must be drained and left open all winter.
- 3. Remove all hoses, y-connectors etc. from outside faucet to ensure proper drainage.
- 4. Once an outside faucet is turned off and drained it may not be turned on before April 15, 2007 without permission from the HOA office
- 5. If the outside valve continues to drip after you have turned off the valve and drained the outside faucet, please contact the Maintenance Department at 84-5469-4018 for assistance.

If you cannot locate the inside shutoff valve, or you need assistance shutting off and draining the outside faucet, please contact the HOA office at 845-469-4018 for assistance.
